Baluster- A small column or vertical shape when placed in a series with a railing becomes a balustrade.

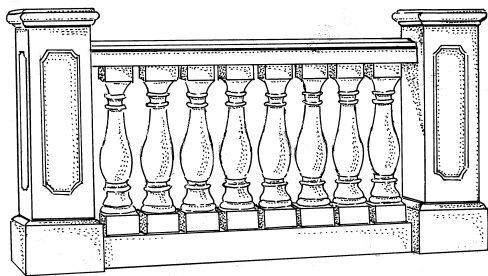

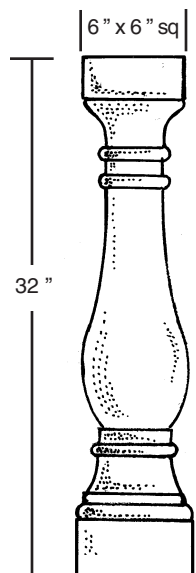
Top Rail



Bottom Rail

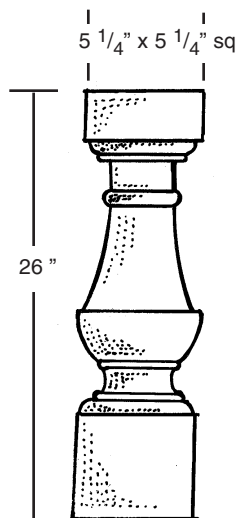

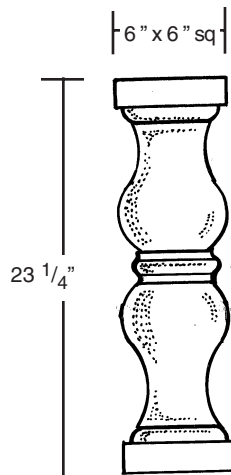

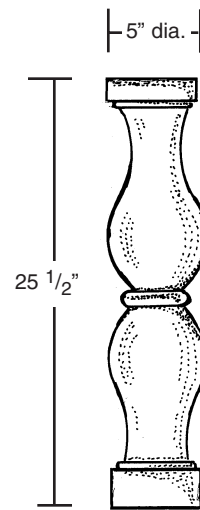

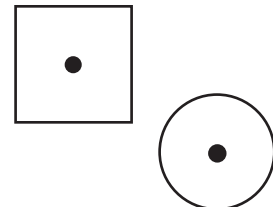
All balusters have a continuous epoxy-coated rebar which protrudes 1 1/2" from the top and the bottom for fastening.
